

S. Lastayev Secondary School, Katon-Karagay village, East Kazakhstan region

The school was included in the project in 2019-100% of teachers have completed advanced training courses, some of them have completed internships in NIS schools.

As part of the project, the classrooms of physics, chemistry, biology, geography, mathematics and logic, computer science, robotics, elementary classes, engineering workshops, cooking, art work and a library have been updated.

The school has opened classes of folk music, children's theater, and the ping-pong training program was launched. The school ensemble in 2022 won the Grand Prix in the international competition of folk ensembles in Almaty.

A partial mechanism of project-based learning is being implemented. For example, making animated cartoons (6th grade students), sewing clothes and bags (7-8th grades students), making fishing gear (5th grade students), modern methods of learning the alphabet for grades zero (2nd grade students), etc.

At the expense of budgetary funds, the school building was overhauled in 2019. The quality of education has risen from 65% to 69% during the project implementation period.

S. Lastayev Secondary School, Katon-Karagay village, East Kazakhstan region

S. Lastaev School is located in Katon-Karagay village and is located 330 km from the regional center. In total, 336 students are trained in the school who are actively engaged in project activities. Many changes took place in the school for 3 years. From the very beginning of the project, the school's teachers participated in courses and seminars organized by Nazarbayev Intellectual Schools, the Center of Excellence, and made many changes to the school's educational system.

"303 out of 336 students of the school were involved in project work.

A total of 54 projects are being prepared in 15 areas. Along with 62 teachers at the school, 4 laboratory assistants and 2 master of vocational training participate in various research projects related to the subjects taught,"

Galiya Doskanina, the School Director says.

At school, much attention is paid to projects to increase love for the native land. So students in this academic year carry out design and research work on the following topics: "Katon-Karagay Toponymy", "Katon-Karagay Petroglyph", "Kumyz and its Properties", "Determination of Soap Oil Content", "Adaptation of the Bozarsha Tree to Katon-Karagay".



Secondary School in Ulken Naryn village, East Kazakhstan Region

The school was included in the project in 2019-100% of teachers have completed advanced training courses, some of them have completed internships in NIS schools.

As part of the project, the classrooms of physics, chemistry, biology, geography, mathematics and logic, computer science, robotics, elementary classes, engineering workshops, cooking, art work and a library have been updated.

There is a ping-pong school, project work has been launched among students on the basis of updated classrooms and workshops.

At the expense of budgetary funds, the school building was overhauled in 2019. The quality of education has risen from 59% to 65% during the project implementation period.

The number of winners of national and international Olympiads has almost doubled: from 65 to 126 students.

Secondary School in Ulken Naryn village, East Kazakhstan region

The schools participating in the project "Rural School Powered by NIS" demonstrate growing indicators not only in the preparation of schoolchildren, but also in the professional development of teachers. Now teachers and students of schools take prizes in the top Olympiads of Kazakhstan.

3 teachers entered the TOP-100 best teachers of Kazakhstan-2022

Nine teachers won prizes in the Republican Pedagogical Olympiad "Zeiyn", six teachers – in the Olympiad "Best Teacher 2022", one teacher won the regional competition "Best Primary School Teacher of a New Format", three teachers of the school entered the Top 100 best teachers of Kazakhstan in 2022.

Secondary school students actively participate in district, regional, republican, international competitions and Olympiads. Thus, the number of Olympiad participants from the school has increased 3 times since the beginning of the project: from 21 to 70 students, more than half of the participants took prizes.

The number of schoolchildren has also increased, if in 2020 there were 253 students studying at the school, today 315 students are studying.







Secondary School in Uryl, Katon-Karagay district, East Kazakhstan region

The school was included in the project in 2021–100% of teachers have completed advanced training courses, some of them have completed internships in NIS schools.

As part of the project, the classrooms of physics, chemistry, biology, geography, mathematics and logic, computer science, robotics, elementary classes, engineering workshops, cooking, art work and a library have been updated.

The school has opened classes of folk music, puppet theater, and also launched a ping-pong training program. There is a scout school in the school.

The quality of education has risen from 69% to 75% during the project implementation period.

Gymnasium School in Makinsk, Akmola region

The school actively implements innovative practices and technologies for the organization of training, teaching, evaluation, educational work, given the experience of specialists of Nazarbayev Intellectual Schools.

One of the areas of study were activities that help to reveal the creative, educational and research abilities of students.

So, a circle "Modeling and design of school clothes" was introduced for middle-level students, schoolchildren were able to decorate the yard themselves after studying in the circle "Designing and Modeling of Street Furniture", a training course on mobilography was organized on the initiative of sponsors of the project "Rural School Powered by NIS".

In September 2022, the school launched another project that is very important in the environmental education of students, "Separate Waste Collection". In a specially built greenhouse, the children were able to grow their first crop.

The real center of attraction for children was the school library, which was equipped with modern equipment and a coworking area was opened in it.

The complex of measures allowed to improve the quality indicators of the school, our students began to spend more time at school with interest, and now we already see how academic performance is growing, prize-winning places at the Olympiads. We are happy that we have become a part of the project and continue to participate in it

RURAL SCHOOL POWERED BY NIS Educational tour for 25 teachers of rural schools

On May 4 and 5, an educational tour for heads and teachers of participating schools of the project "Rural School Powered by NIS" was held in Astana in order to introduce the best standards of education in regions.

On the first day, the tour participants visited the capital's schools #85, #89, #8, Binom, NIS FMN, the Palace of Schoolchildren, as well as Centers of Children's National Sports "Arka Alan" and National Center of Applied and Decorative Arts "Art Tumar". Schools and centers were specially selected in such areas as the modernization of education, the organization of an effective educational process, the design of the educational environment, inclusive education, aesthetic education, the basics of a healthy lifestyle.

The second day of the tour was devoted to training events conducted by the best trainers of the Center of Excellence and the Center for Pedagogical Measurements of the capital. At master classes and seminars, teachers were told about the methodology and technology of teaching, lesson planning, differentiated learning, formatted and summative assessment, as well as the well-being of students.

Development of the potential of hub schools in rural areas

The program "Rural School Powered by NIS" has successfully proved itself in 5 schools in 3 districts of the country.

About KZT800 million of private sponsorship funds were attracted. Thanks to this, 2,800 schoolchildren have access to high-quality education.

During the 3 years of the project implementation, the quality of education has significantly increased in the participating schools of the "Rural School Powered by NIS" project, schoolchildren have become more likely to participate and take prizes in international Olympiads, the level of satisfaction of teachers from working conditions and confidence in their knowledge and skills has qualitatively increased. As a result, the school modernization model developed by the FSDE was supported by Kazakhstan Khalkyna fund.

Thus, the partners have launched the project "Development of the Potential of Hub Schools in Rural Areas", which is designed to provide methodological and material support to 17 schools in 17 regions of the country.

Money of Kazaketan Khalkyna fund will be used only for the equipment of new modification classrooms, which are donated directly to schools.

The operational costs and expenses of training programs and methodological support are borne by FSDE.






The project was highly appreciated by teachers, parents and education experts.


